Recreational Tumbling News:

Our Theme this month is: “Flaky Friends” like snowflakes. Our skill focus will be: Continuing to work on [skill combinations](#) and [improving the speed, form, and smoothness](#) of the connections. (Taking out pauses and just making it more fluid.)

We are so excited about this New Year! We have been able to obtain the ‘pre-school’ room as your child’s new place to practice and learn their skills for the Floor. This new Tumbling space has 500 square feet - a huge improvement over their previous Floor space of 250 square feet – Double what they use to have! If your child is in the Tumblebugs (age 3-7) and some Flip Factory (age 8+) classes and/or has either Coach Sharla, Coach Kya, or Coach Christel they will be learning their Floor skills in this new room, located right next to the parents waiting area. We will still teach your child new progressions and skills for the floor on the Trampoline and Pit.

Since we will be having the younger children closer to the parents waiting area, we are requesting that you help keep distractions to a minimum. The parents’ area is designated as a place for viewing, not for playing tag, chase, ball, etc, please help us create a positive, calm learning environment, which you pay for, for your child(ren). We also need help in keeping siblings off the half wall, this is not safe and distracting to your little tumbler.

Competitive Tumbling News:

Reminder: Required practice for those Tumblers who are competing: For Pre-Team to Level 6 (this is the mon/wed class that comes from 4-6) will practice Jan 3rd 4-6pm. For Level 7 to Sr. Elite (these are the classes that come on mon, tue, or wed from 6-8pm) will practice Jan 3rd 6-8p. For those who come on Friday's you will train on Jan 4th 4-6pm.
